After successful completion of this class, students will be able to explain core concepts in the context of corporate responsibility and sustainable development, understand the importance of international and intercultural aspects in this context, appreciate the importance of ethics and critical thinking, critically reflect on their roles as members of business organizations and professional associations, and apply the concepts they have learned in class to real-life problems in international business.
